The Modules

FOUNDATION IN CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY

This module covers current issues in corporate responsibility, sustainability and accountability, their key drivers and benefits, and the regulatory context.

FOUNDATION IN STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

This module equips delegates with a thorough understanding of the rationale and benefits of stakeholder engagement, and how to undertake effective stakeholder engagement. Lectures and practical exercises cover the AccountAbility and UNEP stakeholder engagement methodology.

FOUNDATION IN SUSTAINABILITY REPORTING

This module covers the purpose and benefits of sustainability reporting and the key principles underlying effective reporting, such as materiality. The GRI G3 Guidelines are covered in detail, and delegates assess their application to case study reports.

SUSTAINABILITY ASSURANCE PRACTITIONER TRAINING

This module covers the principles underlying sustainability assurance, including the changes to the revised AA1000 Assurance Standard. Delegates gain experience of assurance through a team-based assurance exercise. This module is two days.
